



**Professional Institute for Leadership, Learning & Results (PILLAR)  
Leadership & Curriculum Course  
December 2, 2016 – February 5, 2017**

Leadership is both a science and an art. Anchored in practice, leadership must be fostered, observed, assessed, and reformed if it is to be credible and effective. PILLAR, developed through a collaborative partnership between Intermediate Unit 1, the Grable Foundation, and OnHandSchools can help to meet these challenges through an innovative alternative to continuing education for PK-12 administrators.

The Leadership & Curriculum course focuses on traits that must be present in order to be an effective Curricular Leader. The first revolves around development of a Cultural Leader: how can administration effectively develop meaning, ownership for innovation, and quality throughout the school? This is followed by the Accountable Leader – the person who accepts responsibility for expected outcomes, both good and bad. The last lesson represents a culmination of Cultural and Accountable leadership: the Curricular Leader who knows how to gather, analyze and use data to inform decisions as leader of quality teaching and learning.

Course instruction will be provided through a blended learning approach that includes online coursework and discussion, fieldwork, and in-person coaching.
